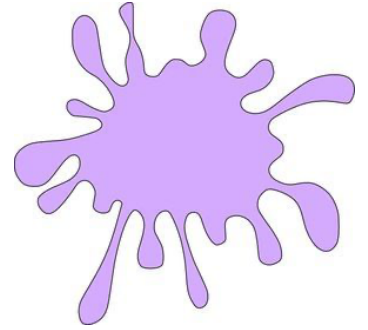
Student Placement for Next School Year

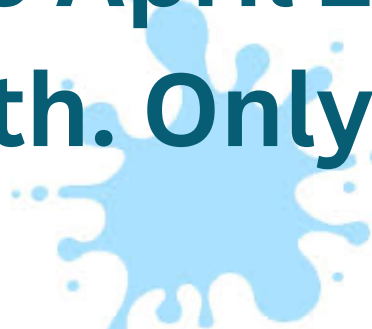
